In light of the current public health crisis caused by COVID19, this summer students will continue the oral history project but with shift from a focus on Lake Michigan. Students will continue to use the digital humanities including conducting interviews and taking photographs to document the phenomena. *Talkin' the Wauk* collaborators will support our efforts with the following:

CAG: Zoom or in-person session/panel with members whose (current or past) career involved the environment. Goal: For students to understand how human activity contributed to the origin, spread, and mitigation of the virus.

WHS: Zoom or in-person session on the 1918 Pandemic and how it affected Waukegan, lessons learned and lingering questions, as well as primary sources

WPL: Zoom or in-person session on equipping students with smart research skills to study the pandemic, identify reliable sources, and apply critical thinking skills. Include a comparison between fake news and real news articles and/or websites related to the current and past pandemics.
